The Pastor’s Paragraph to the CHUM Family

Today United Methodists from all across the world will be celebrating the 70th anniversary of “The Advance for Christ,” or what’s more commonly just called “The Advance.” The Advance was established in 1948 as ‘second mile’ mission giving. That simply means that we pay our primary mission support (or our ‘first mile giving’) each year as part of our Annual Conference’s Shares of Ministry. In 2017 this congregation fulfilled our first mile giving by supporting the missions and ministries supported by our Annual Conference to the tune of about \$100,000. The Advance allows us to support additional, individual mission projects above and beyond those which are supported by our Annual Conference. As you leave worship this morning, CHUM’s mission Team is going to be handing you a chocolate heart, encouraging all of us to ‘Have a HEART for world missions! ---Pastor Tom Willard
